PROCESS	Faculty receive email from URO regarding deadline and instructions on how to submit enrollment confirmation. Faculty access Enrollment Confirmation in WebAdvisor to indicate if a student has <i>never</i> attended any class or no other evidence of class attendance.	Faculty receive an email from the Center for Learning & Academic Success (CLAS) with a link to their roster where they submit their Early Alerts.
