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- When I was researching online MHA programs

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that had the CAHME accreditation,

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there were other programs that have it,

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although it's rarer for an online program

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to have the CAHME accreditation.

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For Suffolk to have this accreditation

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for both their in-person and their online programs

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really speaks to how rigorous the curriculum is,

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how well they're preparing us for the future job market,

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how well they're preparing us

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for any position we might step into as healthcare leaders.

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I spent a lot of time kind of browsing postings of positions

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that were of interest, looking at what the requirements

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for stepping into those roles might be,

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and although for most of these roles, it does always,

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almost always mentions a requirement

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of having an MHA or an MBA,

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many of these postings also stated

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that they would prefer a graduate

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from a CAHME-accredited institution.

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I felt very strongly that I wouldn't get the same caliber

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of education going to a program

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that didn't have the CAHME accreditation,

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and getting to know the program,

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having opportunities to learn about why it is such a unique

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and welcoming and challenging program all at the same time

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really told me that this was the best,

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the best investment that I could be making for my education.

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
