

Graduate Grant and Fellowship Information

General Information

Grant and fellowship opportunities are offered through the Sawyer School of Management, College of Arts and Sciences, and various administrative offices on campus. Award amounts, selection criteria and employment responsibilities vary, so please refer to each school or department for specifics. To be considered for a grant or fellowship a student must be enrolled at least half-time (normally 6 credits per semester). However, please be advised that most fellowships are awarded to full-time students (12 credits per semester).

A student may only accept ONE employment/fellowship offer and all students are limited to 19.75 hours of employment per week.. Most grants/fellowships are renewable for up to 4 semesters provided all renewal requirements (academic progress, enrollment status, etc.) are met. Fellows are normally selected by July 1st so if you have not received notification by that date it is usually safe to assume you will not be awarded a fellowship. International students may be considered for fellowships if the student has a valid I.N.S. authorization for on campus employment.

College of Arts and Sciences

Grant and employment funding is available in the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS). Awards may be based on merit, need, or a combination of the two and can vary in each department. Students enrolled in a Sociology, Government, Communications/ Journalism, Computer Science or Psychology (PhD) program are automatically considered for all merit grants. Students enrolled in the Education department should apply directly to the department for consideration. Students applying to the Education department are encouraged to work directly with the department to obtain specifics on selection criteria, job responsibilities, etc.

Students are usually required to submit a letter of application, academic transcript(s) and a resume. Graduate students in CAS may also apply for administrative fellowships (see below).

Administrative Fellowships

A number of administrative offices award fellowships, however most recipients are usually students enrolled full-time (12 credits). For a full-time student, a \$13,000 award- \$7,200 posted as a grant and \$5,800 paid bi-weekly based upon 16 hours of work per week for 30 weeks. Selection criteria must be obtained from the specific department. To apply, forward a cover letter, resume and academic transcript to any of the departments listed below.
