## **Results of the Spring 2010 Graduating Exit Survey**

### Undergraduate Responses

80% are satisfied with their overall college experience.

79% are satisfied with Suffolk University overall.

23% of seniors reported that they plan to attend graduate school by Fall 2010.

70% of seniors said they would recommend Suffolk University to others.

### Graduate Responses

88% of graduating students are satisfied with the overall quality of instruction.

84% are satisfied with their overall college experience.

81% of graduating students are satisfied with Suffolk University overall.

87% of respondents expect to be working full-time and 6% plan to continue their education by Fall 2010.
