The first Subcommittee meeting was devoted to a presentation on Suffolk's Residential Program and its Police and Security Department.

The presentation on Suffolk's Residential Program included descriptions of the residence life staff, rules and regulations in the dorms (no alcohol) and move-in procedures. It was also explained by Suffolk that the dorms will not be vacant during the summer as there are many summer programs. A *Guide to Residence Life* was handed out to all who attended this meeting.

The second half of the meeting centered on Suffolk's Police and Security Department. Chief John Pagliarulo introduced himself to the subcommittee and presented on crime statistics, security and practices. It was explained that Suffolk has an extensive security system in place in the dorms including the presence of an officer 24 hours a day at the door. Chief Pagliarulo also explained how his department has a close relationship with the Boston Police Department.

The last minutes of the meeting were devoted to questions on such issues as safety coordination between Emerson College and Suffolk, future presence of cameras near the 10 West Dorm and possible shared Emerson/Suffolk community benefits.
