

On a limited, selective basis, individuals with strong undergraduate academic performance and a minimum of three years full-time work experience have the opportunity of enrolling in a maximum of six credits of MBA core courses or MSF prerequisite courses (not including MBA 600, MBA 780, or MBA 800) while preparing for their GMAT and assessing their motivation and ability to complete successfully the MBA, Global MBA, MSF, or MSFSB degree. Admission into MAPS requires a MAPS application, transcripts, resume, and one letter of recommendation. If a participant subsequently meets all formal admission requirements for the Suffolk MBA programs or the MSF, the six credits of core courses taken in MAPS will be credited toward their degree.

Completed applications MUST be received a minimum of three weeks prior to the first day of class in any given semester or summer term.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Due to Immigration and Naturalization Service regulations, this option is only available to US citizens and permanent residents.
- Financial aid is not available for MAPS students because it is not a degree program.

Criteria for Admission

- Minimum 2.8 GPA
- Minimum three years professional work experience
- MAPS Application

Step 1-Submit the following to the Assistant Dean/Dean of MBA Programs:

- MAPS application with your signature
- Copies of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts. Official transcripts are highly recommended.
- Resume
- One letter of recommendation

Step 2-Advising

If admitted, you must have an advising appointment (can be via phone or in person) regarding registration, taking into consideration your transcripts, possible waivers, course prerequisites, and your particular needs.

Step 3-Register

You will be issued a University ID number. Register for a maximum of six MBA CORE credits, excluding MBA 600, MBA 780, and MBA 800.

Step 4-Complete MAPS program

At the completion of MAPS courses, apply officially to the Suffolk MBA, Global MBA, or MSF/MSFSB program. If accepted, credits taken in MAPS will apply to your degree.
