*When living on-campus you will be provided with the following...*

Bed Frame and Mattress

Dresser

Wardrobe/Closet

Suites at 150 Tremont will be provided with lounge furniture: sofas, chairs, end tables, coffee table, dining table and dining chairs

Apartments at 10 West will be provided with the above plus fully appliance kitchen: refrigerator, stove/oven, microwave, and dishwasher.

### *What to Bring*

Sheet set (extra long twin)

Small microwave

Comforter

Cups, Plates, Silverware

Small vacuum

Mattress Protector/Mattress Pad

Automatic shut-off iron/Ironing board

Alarm clock

Surge Protector Power Strip (no extension cords)

Desk lamp

Personal toiletries

Stationary items (pens, pencils etc)

Towels

Laptop/Printer

Shower caddy

Bulletin board/Dry erase board & markers

Hair dryer

USB Flash Drive

Shower shoes

Door mirror

Cleaning supplies for bathroom if you live in a suite or an apartment

Floor lamp

Stereo, TV, DVD player, etc.

Tub mat/Bath rug

Refrigerator (No larger than 4.0 cubic feet)

Laundry supplies/Laundry basket

Painters tape/ Command strips (reduces paint damage!)

Hangers

Under bed storage/ Stackable storage items

### *At 10 West (Apartments Only)*

Same as above plus kitchen supplies (coffee makers, toasters & Forman Grills are OK)

### *What NOT to Bring*

Cooking appliances, including hot pots and coffee pots/makers (only students in 10 West apartments may bring these items)

Illegal drugs and drug paraphernalia

Firearms (including mace and pepper spray)

Candles / Incense

Car – Suffolk University students are not permitted to have cars on campus

Electric heaters

Pocket Knives

Pets (including fish)

Exercise equipment, including free weights

Halogen lamps/Christmas lights

Alcohol, including decorative containers and boxes
