Allowing all the terms to appear anywhere in article may generate thousands of results.

Limiting the location of the terms to the headline and leading paragraph may help to generate fewer but more appropriate results.

Placing certain terms in the Headline or Lead paragraph and other terms anywhere in the document, will limit the results to only those articles which contain the additional term.

The **AND connector** is sufficient for most searches: "**and**" stipulates that **both terms must appear** in the article.

The OR connector expands the search. For example, Iceland OR Norway will retrieve articles that mention either Iceland, or Norway, or both.

The WITHIN connector requires the terms to be present within the designated section of the article.

Most major U.S. papers and many international ones are contained in Lexis. In addition to Boston's major papers, the (***Boston Globe*** and the ***Boston Herald***) LexisNexis also covers the ***New York Times***, the ***Washington Post***, and the ***Financial Times*** of London.

Search for a Single Company:

The **Company Dossier opening screen** retrieves information on a single company from several sources contained within Lexis (Disclosure, CoreData, Hoover's, Directory of Corporate Affiliations, etc.) and gathers it together in one multi-section report, with links to the individual contributing sources.

The lengthy "**Snapshot**" section contains:

- a business description
- stock quotes
- SIC/NAICS codes
- current news
- key competitors
- bond ratings.

Create a list of companies based on specific criteria combinations, such as:

- company type (public, private, subsidiary),
- company size (based on revenue and / or number of employees),
- industry (as defined by SIC or NAICS codes),
- and geographic information.

Note: this form provides a helpful **look-up function for SIC and NAICS codes**. Alternatively, if a company in a given industry has already been identified, use that company's primary SIC code to help identify others in the industry.

In addition, the Search drop-down box offers the option of **searching for terms within the**

- **Business Description**
- **Brands/Products list**
- **or Competitors list.**

Users will be prompted to dictate the amount of information displayed in the final list (contact information, company and financial profiles). The list may be downloaded into **Excel**.

Users may compare up to five companies simultaneously. The resulting report provides a side-by-side comparison of assets, liabilities, income statement, and ratio analysis. Results may be downloaded into **Excel**.

Company Profiles:

In most instances, users will wish to do a simple search by **company name**. This will result in all the available company profiles for that company (or, limit to a specific company profile publisher, such as Hoover's.) Publishers include Disclosure, Hoover's, and Standard & Poor's. Many of these reports are the sources for the consolidated information presented in the Company Dossier single company search.

The **Enter Search Terms** field (with the **Terms and Connectors** radio button activated) will let users generate a list of company profiles based on certain criteria.

SEC Filings

Lexis contains the full-text of the SEC (Securities and Exchange Commission) Edgar filings back to 1993.

A search by **company name or ticker** will retrieve the filings for that company.

Use the **Additional Terms** box to generate a list of SEC filings based on specific criteria. For example, to find filings for companies based in Massachusetts that produce surgical and medical instruments, type: **sic (3841) and state (massachusetts)**, and limit to 10-K forms in the previous year.

[Note: to find the numerical designation of an industry, or **SIC code**, either use the primary SIC code of a company already identified in that industry, or use the look-up function on the

Create a Company List search form.]

The Select Sources drop-down list lets users limit to a specific SEC form, such as the 10-K, 10-Q, 20-F (for issuers registered in foreign countries whose securities traded in the U.S.), the Annual Reports to Shareholders, and the Exhibits.

The **Country Profiles** section allows searches for news and research reports on a particular country.

The **news sources** provide articles on current economic and political conditions, frequently relating to specific industry and business areas. Two sources are devoted to assessing the **potential risk of doing business** in a particular country, and four sources provide information on current **business opportunities**: government contracts, bids, and RFPs (request for proposal).

Not every country is covered by every source. To see information about what each source covers, select the source and click the "i."

Select Country drop-down box:

Search across all countries (for a concept or criteria specified in the Additional Terms box, e.g. Global warming), or choose a single country.

Unfortunately, choosing a single country for an Economic & Political news search, only means that the country is mentioned in the article; the article is not necessarily devoted to that country. Use the Additional Terms box to narrow and focus the search.

Economic & Political News searches may be narrowed by adding additional concepts (climate change **AND** emissions; interest rates **AND** inflation; etc.), which may appear anywhere in the article.

To specify that a term appears in the headline (or headline & lead paragraph) of an article, for example a country name, type:

- **headline (Iceland)** to find articles with the term Iceland in the headline.
- **hlead (Iceland)** to find articles with the term Iceland in the headline or leading paragraph of the article
- **hlead (Iceland) and geothermal** to find articles with Iceland in the headline or lead paragraph, and the term geothermal mentioned anywhere in the article.

Biographical sources:

Newspaper sources are combined together with directory publications to gather multiple biographical information sources under a single search screen. Newspaper articles, obituaries, and specialized directories (providing information on corporate and government leaders, and professionals in law and medicine) are included.

The first option, **Biographies Plus News**, searches a broad range of publications, and is likely to give results for prominent names and professionals in most areas.

Polls and Survey Information

LexisNexis Academic used to provide Polls and Survey information maintained by the Roper Center for Public Opinion Research. These materials are no longer available. LexisNexis does contain news coverage from the Gallup Poll (the Gallup Poll News Service and the Gallup Poll Tuesday Briefing), however as of March 2008, neither of these files were current:

Coverage: From February 20, 2003
Update-Schedule: **Not currently updated.**
- Gallup Poll Tuesday Briefing
Coverage: From January 15, 2002 through March 03, 2006

- **Polls and Surveys** are the index terms.
- **U.S. newspapers and wires** make up the sources.
- The search is limited to the most recent 3 months.
