

Undergraduate Global Travel Seminars McDonnell Scholarships

Undergraduate students who are interested in expanding their understanding and practice of global business are invited to apply for a McDonnell Scholarship. McDonnell scholarships help students offset the program fees associated with the Global Travel Seminars (GTS) offered in the Spring 2009 semester. The GTS seminar fee for each seminar covers the logistical expenses incurred during travel, including airfare, lodging, ground transport, most meals, and business and cultural programming. McDonnell scholarship recipients are responsible for the additional 3 credit course tuition fee and any other costs not covered by the scholarship. Award amounts may range from \$400 to the entire seminar fee.

*Three spaces in each seminar will be held for scholarship recipients in each seminar.
