FUNCTIONAL MAJOR REQUIREMENT (18-24 credits)

All students are required to declare a functional major. Functional majors are specific business disciplines. Choices include Accounting, Entrepreneurship, Finance, Information Systems, Management, Marketing and Public Administration. The courses required for each functional major are specified in the University catalog. After declaring a functional major, you will need the appropriate program of study available through the Undergraduate Programs Dean's Office. For each functional major, 1 course will be taken that is considered "Global".

Experiential Requirement

Students must complete any "Experiential Component" required for their Functional major in addition to the Global Travel Requirement. Experimentals are pre-approved work experiences in the students functional study area.

Free Electives

The number of free elective courses required for your degree will vary based upon the number of required courses for your functional major.

Travel Requirement () IB 560 _____(0cr)

All GB majors are required to participate in overseas travel as a part of their major. This requirement may be satisfied by completing a minimum of one travel seminar or a semester abroad. Travel seminars used to fulfill this requirement, may also be used to fulfill major electives or language

as appropriate. Students may participate in more than one travel seminar and/or study abroad opportunity. All travel must be pre-approved by the Undergraduate Programs Dean's Office to ensure optimum credit distribution.

NOTES:

- 1) **Math Requirement:** Global Business majors who double major in either Finance or Accounting are REQUIRED to complete Math 134 or Math 161. Finance & Accounting majors who have credit for Math 130 may NOT use this course toward the Math Requirement. Students who take Math 104 as a pre-requisite may be able to use Math 104 as a Free Elective.
- 2) **Social Change US and Abroad Requirement (4cr)** Select one: SOC 326 or HST 328 or HST 494 or CJN 485 or GVT 465 or GVT 467. New courses that meet this learning goal will be considered. Please see the Undergraduate Programs Dean's Office.
- 3) **Science Requirement: Critical Analysis Science or Lab Science (4cr)** Choose any science and lab or any 4 credit science course.
- 4) **Language Requirement (8cr):** Two courses in one designated global language. Students with fluency in a global language may seek a waiver. If waiver received, 1 course becomes the Hum and Social Sci Req (4cr) and the 2nd course becomes a free elective(4cr).

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Students are responsible for understanding all University and School policies, procedures and degree requirements. Such information can be found in the University Catalog and Student Handbook. Any exception to the Program of Study must have written approval from the Sawyer Business School Undergraduate Program Dean's Office. **Please be aware that students must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 as well as a 2.0 in the major and minor for graduation.** A minimum of 124 credits is required to be eligible for graduation.
