**Travel Requirement ( ) IB 560 \_\_\_\_\_(0cr)**

All GB majors are required to participate in overseas travel as a part of their major. This requirement may be satisfied by completing a minimum of one travel seminar or a semester abroad. Travel seminars used to fulfill this requirement, may also be used to fulfill major electives, language

or track electives as appropriate. Students may participate in more than one travel seminar and/or study abroad opportunity. All travel must be pre-approved by the Undergraduate Programs Dean's Office to ensure optimum credit distribution.

**\* Refers to courses that will be offered in the 4 credit format beginning Fall 2007. Extra credits earned as a result of this change may be applied to your free elective credit requirements.**

**NOTES:**

1. Math 161 or Math 130 may substitute for this requirement. Students who take Math 104 prior to taking 134, may be able to use Math 104 as Free Elective. ACCT & FIN majors may NOT use Math 130 toward the Math requirement.
2. Literature (3cr): Select one ENG 213, 214, 215, 216, 217, or 218.
3. Science Req. (4cr): One Lab Science or one 4 credit science course.

- 4.Beginning Fall 2007 SOM 101 will be renamed MGT 101 Business Foundations.
- 5.Two courses in one designated global language unless student demonstrates existing bilingual proficiency in a designated Global Language and seeks a waiver. If waiver is received, credits become free electives.
