

# 10 tips to start your Suffolk career off greener

**RECYCLE!** Recycling is available on each floor of administrative and academic buildings.

*Live on campus?* Recycle glass/metal/plastic, paper, and cardboard. Drop-off points located on each floor.

*Live off campus?* Visit [www.suffolk.edu/recycling](http://www.suffolk.edu/recycling) to connect to the recycling program for your town. Request a bin and start recycling!

**LIGHTEN UP!** For your lamps, buy compact fluorescent bulbs instead of wasteful incandescent bulbs.

**REUSE!** See what you can bring from home, instead of buying unnecessary new products.

**REDUCE!** Opt for products that have less packaging.

**SAVE WATER!** Use Suffolk's new dual-flush toilets correctly to save water (and \$). Up for ½ flush, down for full-flush.

**BIKE!** Got a bike? Bring it (and a helmet) for a convenient, pollution-free way to get around the city. If you live on campus, store in your building's bike room. Bike racks are also outside Suffolk buildings.

**BUY SMART!** If you are buying any electronics, choose ones that are Energy Star ([www.energystar.gov](http://www.energystar.gov)).

**DRINK CHEAPER!** Thanks to Suffolk's Mug Club, use a travel mug (instead of plastic, disposable bottles of water) and get 15 cents off your beverage purchases at Suffolk Cafes.

**SAVE TREES!** Buy notebooks that have recycled paper & use both sides of the sheet.

**TURN IT OFF!** Going out? Turn off your computer, TV, lights, and anything else that uses energy.
