All applicants must submit a personal statement of no more than five pages, typed and double-spaced with one-inch margins, and typeface no smaller than 12 point. All questions must be answered in narrative form. Essays not following these formatting guidelines will be disqualified from review. Please respond to the following points:

1. Discuss your educational background and current work. – Why are you a Communications Major?
2. The purpose of the fellowship is to strengthen your work as a creative video producer or director. Discuss your eligibility, relating how your creativity in video production and personal history can make a positive contribution to the profession.
3. Outline your career goals, relating how this fellowship's emphasis on professional development fits into your future plans.
4. Discuss your current financial situation and how the fellowship will benefit you.

**Applications must include the following:**

- A completed essay
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from faculty members or employers, including one from your academic adviser.
- A copy of your current undergraduate transcript.
