Students transfer to Suffolk from all kinds of institutions, all over the country.

Thirteen percent of Suffolk undergraduates are transfer students—and 65 percent of those students transfer from four-year schools.

They do it because we make it easy, with one-on-one academic advising, a special orientation just for transfer students, and an application fee waiver for applicants who visit us in person or virtually.

#### **GUARANTEED ADMISSION WITH MASSTRANSFER**

If you currently attend a Massachusetts Community College, you're guaranteed admission if you're in the final semester of an associate's degree program and have a 2.5 GPA in a qualifying MassTransfer program! Visit **suffolk.edu/masstransfer** for all the details.

# WE MAKE IT AFFORDABLE

Students transfer to Suffolk because we make it affordable, with exclusive transfer scholarships, financial aid, fee waivers, and one of the lowest private university tuitions in Greater Boston.

# **COST OF ATTENDANCE**

- → 2023–2024 tuition: \$44,812
- → 90% of new transfer students received financial aid last year

#### TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Transfer students are automatically considered for exclusive scholarship assistance—ranging between \$5,000 and \$22,000. To be competitive, you should have at least a 3.0 GPA.

#### HONOR SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIPS

The Phi Theta Kappa honor society has placed Suffolk on its 2023 Transfer Honor Roll. If you're a member, you can qualify for a special scholarship and admission to Suffolk's Honors Programs. Alpha Beta Gamma society members are also eligible for special scholarship assistance.

# **HOW TO APPLY**

#### **MATERIALS**

Transfer Common Application (**commonapp.org**), Guaranteed Admission Application (**suffolk.edu/masstransfer**), or Suffolk University Online Application (**uga.suffolk.edu/apply**), plus \$50 application fee (**waived when you visit in person or online**).

- Official transcripts from all colleges attended, sent directly from the institution(s) to Suffolk University
- → Official secondary school transcript (waived if you have an associate's degree or at least 60 transferable credits).
- Official TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo results (non-native English speakers only; waived if you've completed the equivalent of College Writing I and II with a grade of B or higher)
- → Essay/Personal statement
- → Art & design applicants: Portfolio of artwork (suffolk.edu/portfolio)

## TRANSFER CREDITS

We accept up to 75 transfer credits in total. We consider earned grades of C- or higher for transfer credit from a regionally accredited institution or equivalent if international. If admitted, you'll receive a detailed summary showing how your courses transfer to Suffolk, plus your decision letter. You'll also receive a Degree Evaluation form showing your academic progress applied toward a Suffolk degree.

An academic advisor will help you select your classes before orientation.

The majority of our courses are offered in person during normal classroom hours. A limited number of online and evening courses are available.

Note: You cannot complete your entire degree online or in the evening.
