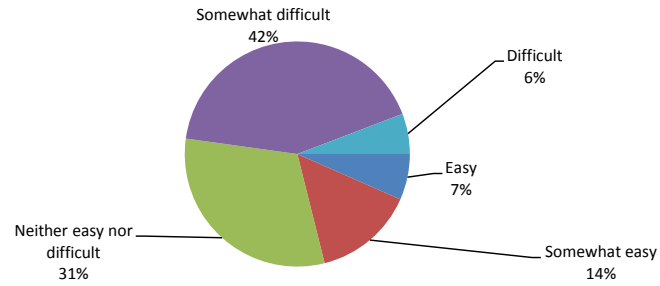

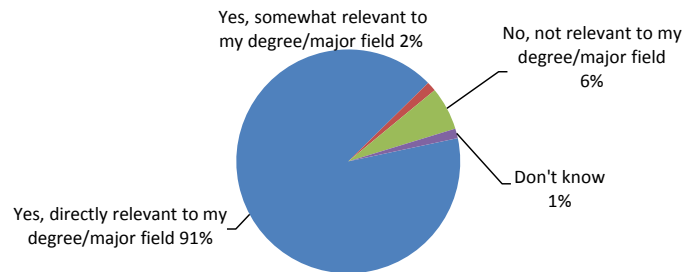

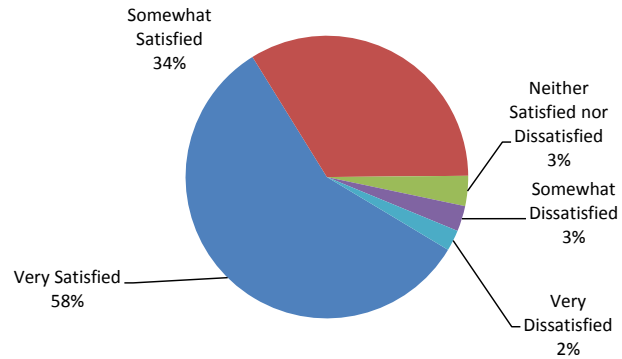

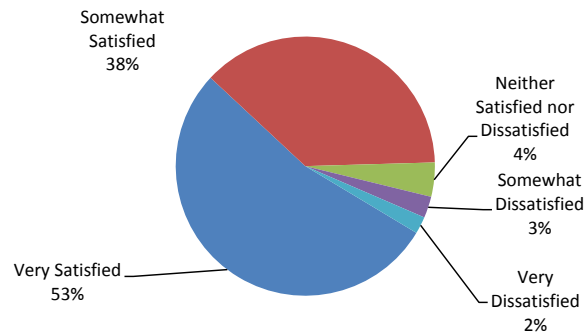
What are the three greatest strengths of your degree program? - Appendix D

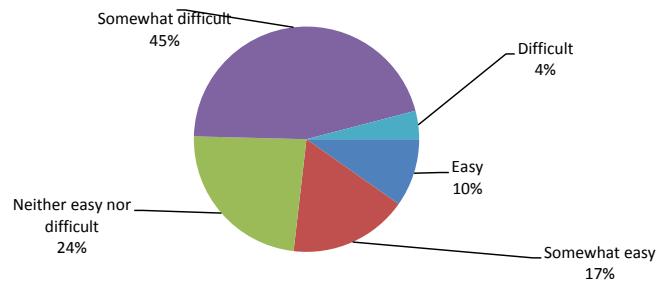

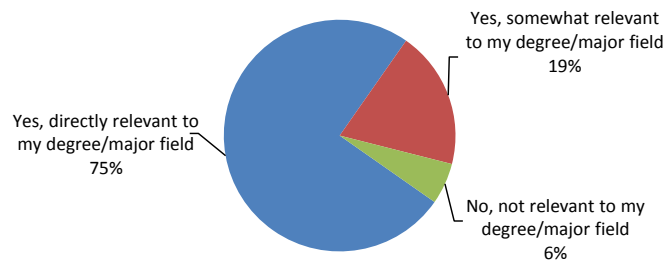

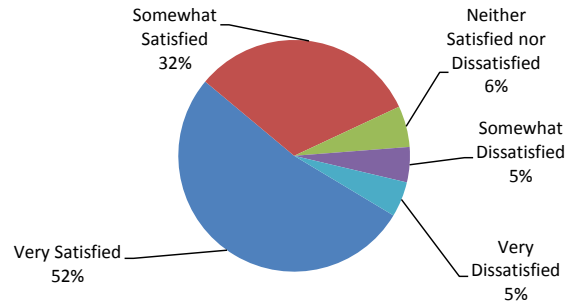

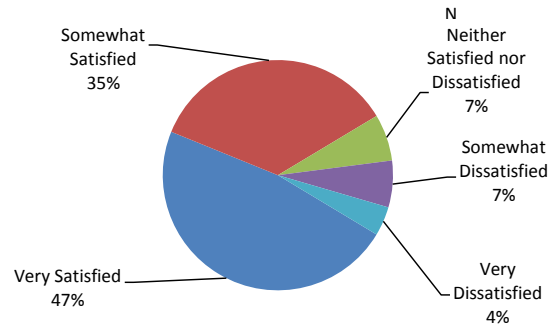

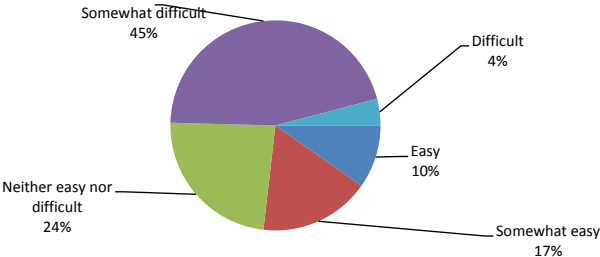

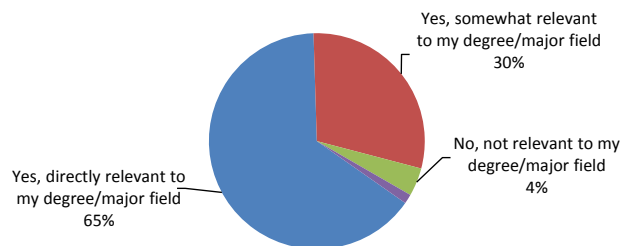

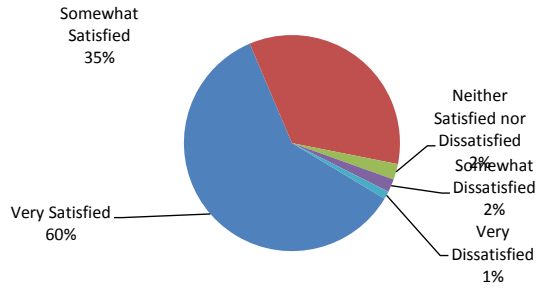

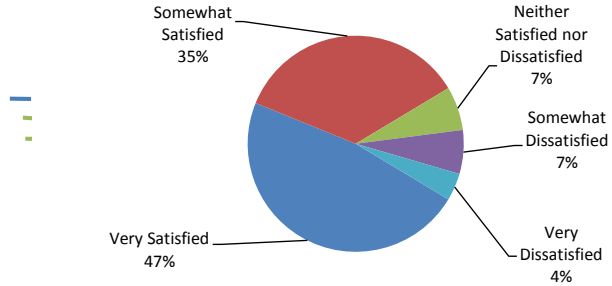
What are the three greatest strengths of your degree program? - Appendix D (CAS)
