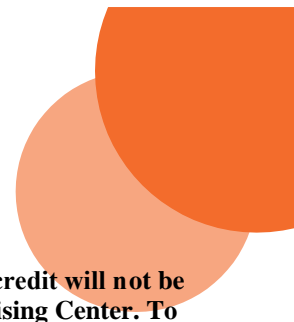


College Level Exam Program (CLEP) Senior Petition Form



Suffolk University's CLEP policy states that exams must be taken prior to a student's last 30 credits. CLEP credit will not be awarded in the senior year unless a student receives approval to take the exam from the Undergraduate Advising Center. To petition for approval to register for a CLEP exam:

- After you complete the form, you must meet with an advisor in the Undergraduate Academic Advising Center.
- If approval has been met, please return a copy of this form to the CLEP Coordinator in the Division of Student Success located at 73 Tremont Street, 9th Floor, Boston, MA, 02108.
- Please note that official registration will require this signed form, the College Board CLEP exam registration ticket, a completed registration form, and a \$30 non-refundable/non-transferable test center fee paid by money order, made out to Suffolk University.
