\*\*\*Students required to complete ENG 099 may be allowed to waive WRI 101 with a grade of “B” or better and the approval of the English Department. Students who are invited to complete WRI 103 and earn a “B” or better satisfy the two Writing Requirements. Waiving a course does not earn credits.

^Some courses may be designated as STE and have a laboratory. In the case of a course that is a lecture plus a lab, the student must complete both components to earn credit for the requirement.
