

## Just-in-Time Online Activities

As is the case with all of the Continuity of Learning activities, students need to clearly understand that learning will continue even when school is canceled for any reason. To prepare students:

- Add your continuity of learning plan to your syllabus
- Engage students in a low stakes online activity early in the semester.  
Example: Use the Discussion Forum for Student Introductions

Examples of Just-in-Time Learning Activities:

<b>Planned In-class Learning Activity</b>	<b>Just-in-Time Online Learning Activity</b>
Discussion of assigned reading (whole class or small group)	Create the discussion in the Discussion Forum; be sure to attach a rubric that includes expectations. Discussions can be created for the whole class or for groups.  Monitor the discussion in order to provide scaffolding when needed; provide feedback to individuals, small groups, and/or whole group.
Short introductory lecture or demonstration.	Use Blackboard Collaborate for a live lecture or demonstration. Record the session for students who are unable to access the internet during the live session.  Give students a follow up exercise for practice or assessment purposes.
