If you use Form 4506-T, make sure you check box 7 and mail/fax the form to the appropriate address/number.
- 2017 W2 forms or a signed statement to verify 2017 income.

In addition the individual must submit a signed and dated statement indicating that he/she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS has been made aware of the tax-related identity theft.
