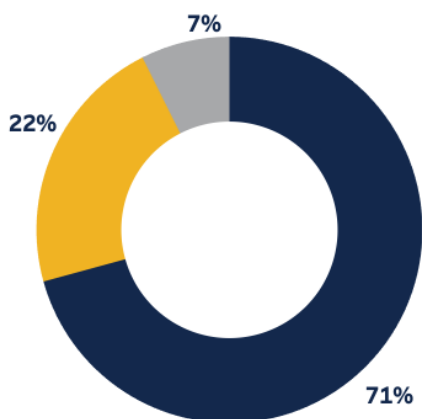
716 out of the total 773 undergraduate-level graduates with known career outcomes (excluding those not seeking) are employed or continuing their education

The Knowledge Rate is the percentage of graduates for whom the institution has reliable and verifiable information regarding post-college career outcomes within 12 months of spring graduation.

This document provides career outcomes information for the Sawyer Business School and College of Arts & Sciences at Suffolk University, specific to the Class of 2024 which includes students who had their degree(s) conferred between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024.

Data collection was conducted over a 12-month period following the May 2024 graduation. Collection methods include surveys, direct outreach through email and phone, professional data scraping, and individual online research. All information is heavily verified to ensure each graduate's post-Suffolk journey is represented as correctly and accurately as possible.

Suffolk University adheres to the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) standards and guidelines, with the exception of extending the research deadline from 6 to 12 months.
