### OUTREACH GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

The Outreach Fellowships are offered in support of students who have a demonstrated and sincere commitment to promoting the well-being of underserved and socially or economically disadvantaged individuals and communities. Demonstration of this commitment should be made through research, service, and clinical activities.

The fellowship provides full tuition remission for the first 72 credits of required coursework as well as a stipend for the first three years of Ph.D. training. Recipients will be required to update and confirm their continuing eligibility with departmental staff in order to continue to receive the fellowship before each succeeding year of their participation.

**The fellowship application and all supporting materials will be accepted beginning December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017.** We encourage interested applicants to submit the application as early as possible. However, all materials must be received no later than 12pm on **January 5, 2018**.
