

Adobe access for Students


The Adobe license installed on all machines in Labs, Classrooms & the VDI (Virtual Desktop) is a Shared Device License.

You must have an Adobe ID to access any Adobe Application

When you choose your desired Adobe Application by selecting from Program Menu.


You will be prompted to Sign In:
