


Adobe access on Public machines for Faculty/Staff

The Adobe license installed on all labs, classroom machines and the VDI (Virtual Desktop) is a Shared Device License.

This is different from the Adobe license installed on your Suffolk computer.

Choose your desired Adobe Application by selecting from Program Menu.


You will be prompted to Login:


When you move to password field, you will be redirected to an Adobe login:
