HBCU Full Tuition Agreement
Suffolk University Law School

IMPORTANT: BEFORE MOVING FORWARD, PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

The Thaddeus Alexander Kitchener Scholarship grants full-tuition scholarships to all incoming students who graduated from one of the identified historically Black colleges and universities and make a commitment during the application process that Suffolk Law is their first choice of institution and, if admitted, the student will definitely enroll in 2027. Completed applications must be received by March 1, 2027, to be considered under this program for the 2027-2028 academic year.

I agree to enroll at Suffolk University Law School beginning in May or August 2027.

I agree not to apply to any other law school's early binding action program, though I may submit non-binding application to other law schools, prior to acceptance.

Upon acceptance at Suffolk Law and grant of a full-tuition scholarship, I agree to withdraw all applications to other law schools and not submit any new applications to other law schools.

If admitted, I agree to pay the nonrefundable \$500 seat deposit by January 13, 2027, or within 21 days of admission to Suffolk Law, whichever is later. I understand that deposit deadline extensions are not available for those admitted through the HBCU Full Tuition Program. I understand that applicants accepted under the HBCU Full Tuition Program may not defer admission.

I understand that with an offer of admission, Suffolk Law may share my name and HBCU Full Tuition Agreement with other law schools.

I understand that all other policies and procedures of Suffolk Law, including all application requirements and university rules and regulations, remain in full force and become part of this Agreement.
