FIRST YEAR IN PERSON

- Spend 1L in person at Suffolk Law in Boston
- Meet and form lasting friendships with classmates in person
- Form in-person study groups
- Must earn 3.0 GPA in first-year curriculum to enroll in online classes
- Full-time or part-time evening

2L & 3L ONLINE FROM ANYWHERE

- Take all of your upper-level courses online (54 credits), or select a mix of in-person or online classes
- Full access to law school building, faculty, and offices
- Work or intern during the summers in Boston or anywhere

ADVANCED PROFESSIONAL ONLINE JD



Currently pursuing formal acquiescence from the American Bar Association (ABA)

FULLY ONLINE PART-TIME EVENING PROGRAM DESIGNED FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO:

- Hold advanced degrees or have significant professional experience (ideal for patent agents, technical specialists, and individuals with advanced academic or professional credentials)
- Are seeking a high-quality legal education without the logistical challenges or relocation requirements of a residential program
- Require the flexibility of an evening, part-time online program

SAME NUMBER OF CREDITS (84) AS TRADITIONAL JD

- No residential requirement
- Evening classes designed for working professionals
- Limited to 36 students per entering class
- 4-year, part-time curriculum
- Synchronous and interactive online courses
