Summer/ Early Fall

- Take Admission Test (LSAT, GRE, or JD-Next)
 - Draft Personal Statement
- Ask for Letters of Recommendation

November

- Attend Suffolk Law's Open House

Spring

- Visit Suffolk Law's campus and observe a class

March 1

- HBCU Full-Tuition Scholarship Deadline

Fall

- Start application to Suffolk Law
 - Re-take Admission Test (if needed)
 - Research Law Schools

December 1

- Application Deadline for Binding Early Decision (BED) Program

February 1

- Application Deadline for Hybrid Online JD, Advanced Professional Online JD, and Accelerated JD Programs

April 1

- Priority Application Deadline
