

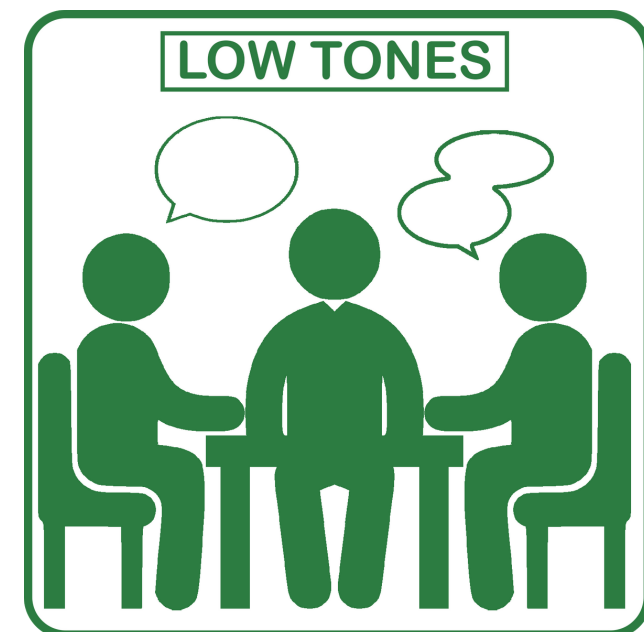
Moakley Law Library Noise Policy

The law library strives to maintain an atmosphere that is conducive to quiet study while also allowing for group work. To further this aim, the law library space is divided into three types:

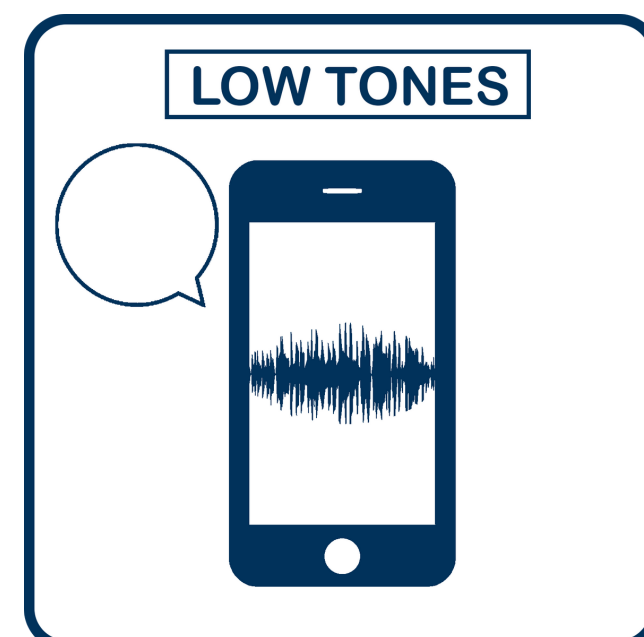
Quiet Spaces are for quiet individual study and reading.



Collaborative Spaces allow for in person conversations in low tones that do not disturb neighboring patrons.



Cell Spaces are for patrons to have cell conversations in low tones without disturbing neighboring patrons.



Cell conversations are prohibited from any other areas in the law library and cell phones must be silenced on entering the law library. Speakerphone conversations are strictly prohibited in the law library.
