The Challenge

Habitat for Humanity Cambodia

Mission: HFH Cambodia seeks to break the cycle of poverty through safe, durable, affordable housing solutions.

- **Primary sectors:** Housing, Livelihood, and Disaster Risk.
- **Opportunity:** Phnom Penh, Cambodia's capital, has experienced tremendous urban growth over the past decade.
- **Challenges:** poor quality housing, infrastructure gaps, low paying jobs, Covid-19, and lack of land tenure and security.



The Process

Four Steps

- Conduct a Feasibility Study.
- Build new climate Housing for most vulnerable households.
- Provide training: 2 days on housing management, safety, and policy & 2 days on livelihood development.
- Provide small grant for livelihood startup.



Reflections

Outcome: Improved housing conditions in urban communities through providing integrated housing solutions.

- **Output 1.1:** Households with access to safe and secure housing.
- **Output 1.2:** Strengthened community knowledge on climate-smart adaptation house management, home maintenance, fire management and housing policy.
- **Output 1.3:** Increase livelihood and income generation through livelihood development training.
