- A copy of an unexpired IRS approval of an extension beyond the automatic six-month extension if the individual requested an additional tax filing extension for the tax year;
- A 'Verification of Non-filing Letter' from the IRS dated on or after October 1, 2021, attesting that you did not file a 2020 IRS income tax return. You can request the 'Verification of Non-filing Letter' on line at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript.
- 2020 W2 forms or a signed statement to verify 2020 income. (If self-employed, a signed statement certifying the amount of the individual's AGI and U.S. income tax paid for the tax year.)

Individuals Who Were Victims of IRS Identity Theft in 2020

- A victim of IRS identity theft who is not able to obtain a 2020 IRS Tax Return Transcript or use the IRS DRT must contact the **IRS at 1-800-908-4490**. Upon authentication of the tax filer's identity, the IRS will provide, a copy of the Tax Return Data Base View (TRDBV) transcript. In addition the individual must submit a signed and dated statement indicating that he/she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS has been made aware of the tax-related identity theft.
