The Counseling, Health & Wellness Center (CHW) provides integrated counseling and health services to Suffolk's significantly diverse population of undergraduate, graduate, and law students. The Internship in Health Service Psychology has been APA-accredited since 1996. Training aims include preparing Interns for entry-level practice in higher education settings, increasing multicultural competency with a focus on social justice, and assistance with the development of an authentic professional and personal identity rooted in professional values, ethics, and knowledge. CHW provides a dynamic and supportive training and working environment for personal and professional growth. Training staff maintain an integrated approach to clinical work, with a focus on empirically based short-term and relational or relational-cultural models. CHW seeks to maintain an inclusive environment for service delivery, staff engagement, and the training of Doctoral Interns; training staff are committed to the provision of services and training which intentionally address issues of diversity and identity, interpersonal sociocultural differences, and social justice.
