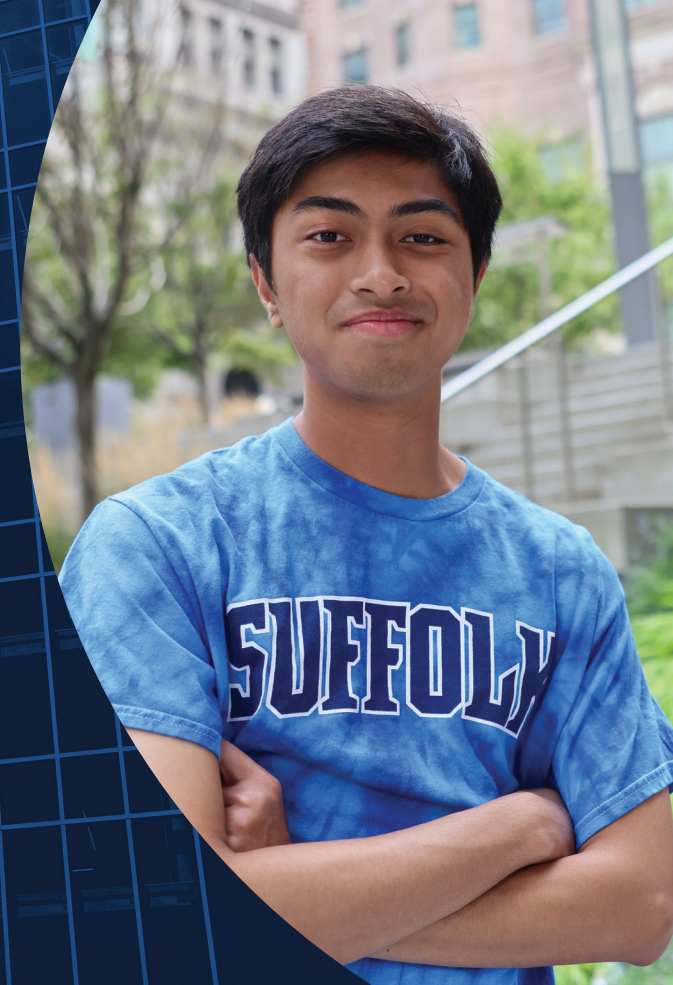

Undergraduate Admission Information

Admission Requirements

- Common Application (commonapp.org) or Suffolk online application (uga.suffolk.edu/apply)
- Essay
- Official secondary school transcript (in English or an accompanying translation)
- One letter of recommendation
- Art & design applicants: Portfolio of artwork
- Proof of English proficiency via one official score report. For more information on our testing-flexible options, visit suffolk.edu/intladmission
- Transfer applicants: Official university/college transcript(s)
- \$50 application fee (waived when you attend an on-campus or virtual visit)

Application Deadlines

November 15: Early action fall entry (freshman applicants)

February 15*: Regular decision fall entry (freshman applicants)

May 1: Enrollment deposit

June 30*: Fall entry (transfer applicants)

December 1*: Spring entry (freshman and transfer applicants)

**Applicants will be considered after these dates on a rolling basis.*

Scholarships & Financial Assistance

All applicants are automatically considered for institutional merit-based aid. Financial aid is available to U.S. citizens and U.S. permanent residents.

After their first semester, students are eligible to apply for on-campus scholar programs, including the Trustee Ambassador Program, Orientation Scholars, and Tutoring Scholars. These positions are part scholarship, part paid stipend.

Advanced Standing Information

Suffolk awards advanced credit—which saves you time and money!—for a wide range of exam scores, including:

- Advanced Placement scores ranging from 3 to 5, depending on the exam
- International Baccalaureate (IB): Higher Level (HL) exams with a score of 4 and above; Standard Level (SL) 5 and above. Sophomore standing is possible for IB diploma recipients.
- A-Level scores of C and higher (Five strong GCSE/IGCSE passes are required for admission.)
- Other examinations such as the French Baccalaureate, German Abitur, Swiss Matura, and the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination
- College/University courses completed with a C- or better. Courses must be similar in content to those at Suffolk and taken at an institution recognized by a Ministry of Education or by a U.S. regionally accredited institution.
