This partnership is designed to make your transition from community college to Suffolk easier, more supported, and more career-focused—so you can hit the ground running after graduation. Benefits include guaranteed admission consideration (if you have a 2.5 GPA or higher); dedicated advising, support, and resources from both institutions; and more.

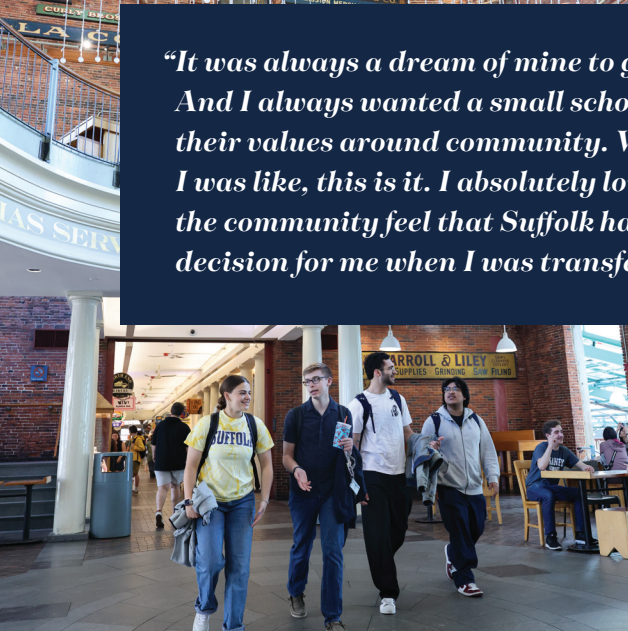
Navigate Campus Life, with *Expert Help*
