



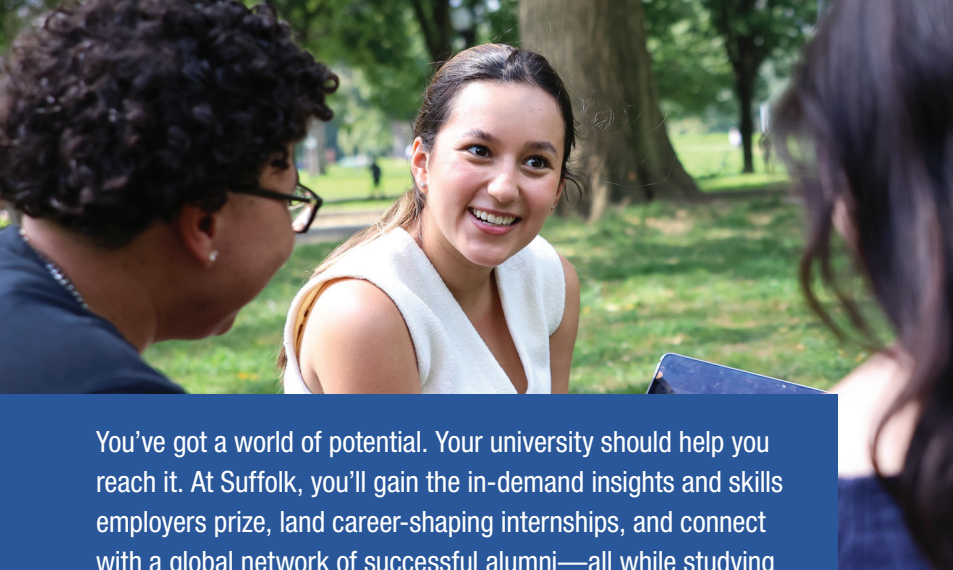

All applicants are automatically considered for institutional merit-based aid. Suffolk's merit scholarships for international students cover up to 50 percent of tuition. Financial aid is available to U.S. citizens and U.S. permanent residents.

After your first semester, you'll be eligible to apply for on-campus scholar programs, including the trustee ambassador program, orientation scholars, and tutoring scholars. These positions are part scholarship, part paid stipend.

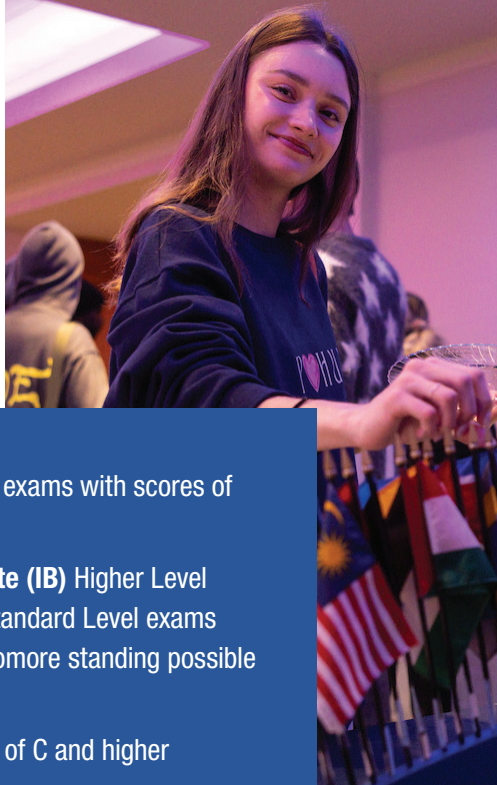
Get Credit for Your Exams

Suffolk recognizes a wide range of advanced coursework and examinations, including:

- **Advanced Placement (AP)** exams with scores of 3–5 (depending on subject)
- **International Baccalaureate (IB)** Higher Level (minimum score of 4) and Standard Level exams (minimum score of 5). Sophomore standing possible for full diploma recipients
- **A-Level** examination scores of C and higher
- National examinations such as the **French Baccalaureate, German Abitur, Swiss Matura, and Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE)**
- **Dual enrollment, college, and university coursework** completed prior to enrollment
